

Golden Time

Golden Time is a weekly timetabled slot of at least half an hour each week where children are able to embark on an activity of their choice. If a child keeps the Golden Rules all week, they automatically have the right to take part in their chosen activity.

There are several benefits to Golden Time:

- It upholds the Golden Rules and acts as an incentive for children to keep them.
- It provides a safe framework as it demonstrates to children that there are immediate consequences for unacceptable behaviours.
- It ensures that children who are normally 'good' are continually acknowledged and rewarded.

Activities included in Golden Time - singing, PE, Board and Strategy Games, Painting, Topic work, Parachute Games, Speed Stacking, Cooking, Choosing Time, Using the Nature Area, Construction, Reading, Educational Films and Golden Moments.
