Year 3 are preparing to go back in time.....We will be having a day of workshops looking at daily life, beliefs and practices in Ancient Rome!

We would love the children to come to school dressed as a Roman!

Here are some simple ideas:



All Roman clothes can be made from large rectangles of cloth with minimum sewing.

To make a tunic, you can just fold a piece of cotton – e.g. an old (clean) sheet – in half and cut a slit for the neck (be careful not to make the slit too big). Finish off with a belt. Tunics can be long or short. Sides can be sewn up or left open. *Put a tee shirt and shorts underneath for warmth!* Appropriate jewellery can also be worn.

Or, just use a large baggy white tee-shirt (over shorts again) with a belt.

Alternatively, you may want to dress as a soldier!
