As part of our Sikhism topic this term, we are visiting the Gurdwara in Hitchin on **Wednesday 13th February 2019**. There will be no worship. The children will be shown around the Gurdwara and taught about the Sikh religion and culture. As the Gurdwara is a place of Sikh worship, as a mark of respect all visitors, boys and girls, are requested to cover their hair, for example with a head scarf. We will be discussing this in class.

We will be leaving school at 9 am and will return by 12:30pm. Children will have lunch in school as usual.

The PTA have kindly contributed £300 towards the cost of the coach in order to make this more affordable for parents. Although this represents a saving of £5 per child we would still be grateful to receive a voluntary contribution of £2 towards the cost of the trip. Should there be insufficient contributions to cover costs we will regrettably have to cancel the visit. The trip will form the basis of wider learning in class, including follow up lessons across the curriculum.
