Y6 Walk to River Ver - 2019

Dear Parents,

As part of our Rivers topic, we intend to walk a section of our local river – The Ver – in St Albans on Tuesday 12th February. We plan to meet at 8.50 close to where the Alban Way begins, at the point where Cottonmill Lane meets Leyland Avenue (see map below).



The children will need to be dropped at this location directly, rather than coming to school first. We will be there from 8.30. **Please confirm below that arrangements are in hand for this to happen; alternatively, please let us know if this is going to cause difficulty and we will look at making alternative arrangements for your child.**

The children should wear their usual uniform (to include school trousers unless it is a girl who does not wear school ones, in which case suitable alternative trousers may be worn), a waterproof and sturdy shoes (which will get muddy and, possibly, wet). They will also need their usual school bag and their packed lunch (if they would have one anyway) although it should be noted that we will be returning to school for normal lunch. They should travel as light as possible – the only other item that they will need is a water bottle.

We do need a number of parent volunteers to come on the walk. Please indicate below if you are able to come.
